

## **SPECIAL VESTRY MEETING**

**Sunday 1 August 2021 commencing at approximately 10.45am**

The Vestry shall under the leadership of and with the Parish Priest be responsible for the pastoral, educational, evangelistic and missionary work of the parish. The Vestry meeting of great spiritual and material importance to the Parish. In this special meeting, the whole Parish will choose a new People's Churchwarden, commencing immediately and continuing until the 2022 Vestry Meeting.

**Nominations are now being called for:**

**Churchwarden - commonly referred to as 'People's Warden'**

Any number of persons may be nominated for this positions. A nominated person must be over 18, be baptised and be a communicant member of the Anglican Church. It is encouraged that they worship regularly on Sundays and give financially to the work of the Parish.

Completed nomination forms should be given to the Revds Julie Worrall or Jeff Oake **by no later than Friday 30 July 2021.**

## **THE ROLE OF THE PARISH COUNCIL**

The Parish Council is elected and appointed to a particular responsibility of leadership, and is involved in sharing and forwarding the work of ministry in the Parish. Councillors bring to meetings the feelings and thoughts of Parishioners, as well as communicating the decisions of the Parish Council to Parishioners.

The Parish Council is responsible for *'the worship, ministry and mission of the parish under the leadership of the Parish Priest'*; for the drawing up of an annual budget; for the administration of Parish funds; and to keep all Parish Trust Property (the Church and the Rectory) in good repair. Parish Councillors form a leadership body and are concerned with the overall interests, spiritual and material, of the whole Parish. Their vision is broader than just those who come to worship, it is appropriate that they remind the whole Council of the needs of the wider community among whom we minister.

## **WHO IS ON THE PARISH COUNCIL?**

The Parish Council is made up of the Parish Priest, Licenced Assistant Clergy, Church Wardens, elected and nominated Councillors. From those appointed and elected to Parish Council, a Treasurer is appointed. At this Meeting of Parishioners only the People's Warden will be elected - all other positions were appointed at the Annual Vestry Meeting in March 2021.

Julie and Jeff further request Parish Councillors to maintain close contact with the congregation, particularly on Sundays and at Parish social functions. Through this year it is also hoped that Parish Council will establish a few working groups to encourage the participation and involvement of people 'beyond members of Council' and Councillors are encouraged to participate in one of the working groups which have a focus on: Property & Maintenance, Fundraising, Pastoral Care, or as determined by the Council once elected.

Council meetings have been held on the second Tuesday of each month, 7.30pm. The next meeting is **Tuesday 17 August 2021 at 7.30pm** (a change of usual meeting date was made by Parish Council at their July meeting). We aim to conclude meetings by 9.30pm. The meeting time this year will be determined by the new council at this first meeting. An Agenda and Minutes of the previous meeting are made available beforehand.

**The Churchwardens** join with the Parish Priest in being the *'executive and standing committee of the Parish Council'*. They disburse the funds of the Parish, subject to the direction of the Parish Council, and carry out the policy of the Parish Council in the daily affairs of the Parish.


