Next Session – Overpopulation: the elephant in the room Wednesday 20 October 2021 at 7 pm

The speaker will be <u>Dr James Hopeward (né Ward)</u>, Associate Professor in Environmental Engineering, UniSA STEM. Dr Hopeward's research focuses on 'big-picture sustainability problems such as the limits to the planet's energy supplies, climate change and economic growth'. He was a lead author on the <u>UN's 6th Global Environmental Outlook Report</u>, a founding member of the <u>Wellbeing Economy Alliance</u> and a past National President of <u>Sustainable Population Australia</u>. Dr Hopeward will speak for thirty to forty-five minutes, followed by audience questions and brief comments, moderated by the Chair to ensure open and respectful discussion.
